This FREE program meets the first Wednesday of the month from 9:15-10:15 a.m. Our goal is to facilitate friendship among new parents and discussion of parenting topics.

Almost Two

For children turning two between November and April. Half year with parent/caregiver. Half year separation. Meets Wednesdays and Fridays from 9:15-10:45 a.m. from October to December and 9:15-11:30 a.m. from January to June.

2's - Garinim (Seeds)

The process of gradual, supported separation of child from parent or caregiver begins. Implemented on an individual basis and taking into account each child's unique timetable, our approach to separation respects maturation and experience. Our goal is to gently develop the trust and confidence your child will have in the ECC as a safe, comfortable place. Two year old programs meet three, four or five mornings a week from 9:00 a.m. - 12:00 p.m.

3's - Shorashim (Roots) & 4's - Prachim (Flowers)

Children explore an environment rich in materials that promote social, emotional, physical, intellectual and spiritual development. The classroom environment embraces and reflects successful models of early childhood practice. The natural outdoor environment surrounding the JCCH is also considered the children's classroom and is a vital aspect of the curriculum.

Our 3's and 4's meet five mornings a week (9:00 a.m.-12:00 p.m.) with the option of two or five afternoons (12:00-2:30 p.m.) for special enrichment activities. Children may bring dairy lunch from home.


