Helping to ensure a safe environment for our students is a top priority at the Kehilah School.

Last week we shared a message from JCCH President Marty Rogowsky pertaining to cleaning procedures at the school. We are working hard with our own custodial team, as well as a contracted cleaning service, to provide clean, disinfected learning spaces for your children.

Now, we are turning to you to help us.

Attached to this email is a google form containing a list of questions regarding your child's health. (Click [here](#) for the form.) Needless to say, the health of one child potentially affects the health of every other child in the school as well as that of the teachers and the staff.

**As we are all responsible for one another's safety: No child will be allowed in class without first completing the preclearance form, prior to being dropped off at the JCCH. This form needs to be completed online at the above link for each child every day at least an hour prior to the start time (in person) of school. We will monitor form responses from the JCCH.**

Should we become aware of a case of COVID-19 in our school or synagogue community, of course we will advise you immediately and we will follow the advice of medical professionals. In addition, our teachers are prepared to shift to Zoom learning if need be. (Our professional staff spent much of the summer taking professional development coursework aimed at creating engaging online experiences for young learners.)
